I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Section I, General Orders 4, 1971, is corrected to read as follows:

GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 15 December 1970, the Commanding Officer, Fort Carson and 4th Infantry Division (Mechanized), Fort Carson, Colorado, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial.

II. U.S. ARMY PERSONNEL CENTER, FORT HAMILTON. Effective 15 May 1971, the U.S. Army Personnel Center, Fort Hamilton, a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First U.S. Army is discontinued.

III. SENIOR ROTC UNIT. So much of DA General Orders 4, 28 January 1971, as pertains to the establishment of a Senior ROTC unit at Grambling College, Grambling, Louisiana, is rescinded.

IV. JUNIOR ROTC UNIT. Effective 4 January 1971, the name of Irvington High School, Omaha, Nebraska, was changed to Northwest Senior High School.
