**I. HEADQUARTERS, FIFTH UNITED STATES ARMY.** Headquarters, Fifth United States Army less personnel and equipment is transferred from Fort Sheridan, Illinois, to Fort Sam Houston, Texas, *effective 30 June 1971*. Personnel and equipment determined to be surplus as a result of this action will be reassigned or disposed of in accordance with applicable directives.

**II. HEADQUARTERS, FOURTH UNITED STATES ARMY.** Headquarters, Fourth United States Army is inactivated *effective 30 June 1971*. Its missions, functions, installations, activities, personnel, records, and equipment are concurrently reassigned or transferred to the command jurisdiction of the appropriate CONUS Army.

**III. DEFENSE SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT SCHOOL.** *Effective 1 July 1971*, the Defense Systems Management School (DSMA) is established at Fort Belvoir, Virginia.

**IV. NATIONAL BOARD FOR THE PROMOTION OF RIFLE PRACTICE.** General Orders 3, 19 January 1971, is amended as follows:

1. *Effective 29 January 1971*, MG William E. McLeod, Director, Organization, Unit Training and Readiness Directorate, OACSFOR, Department of the Army, is appointed to membership on the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice, to serve the unexpired term of MG Alexander R. Bolling, Jr. USA.

2. In addition, so much of footnote as pertains to MG Maxwell E. Rich, USA (Ret) appointed 21 December 1970 to 2d term should be amended to read 1st term.

**V. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS.** *Effective 1 April 1971*, class HS JUNIOR ROTC units were established at the following institutions under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence September 1971.

Guam Vocational-Technical High School, Mangilao, Guam
