- I--GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 10 May 1971, the Commanding Officer, United States Army Europe and Seventh Army Combat Support Command, APO New York 09102, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial.
- II_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 16 May 1971, the Commanding Officer, United States Army Forces, Military Region 2, APO San Francisco 96350, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial.
- III_SENIOR ROTC UNIT. 1. A Senior ROTC unit will be established at Wisconsin State University-Platteville, Platteville, Wisconsin effective for enrollment at the beginning of the academic year 1971-72.
- 2. So much of section II, DA General Orders 4, 28 January 1971, as pertains to the establishment of a Senior ROTC unit at Stout State University, Menomonie, Wisconsin is rescinded.
- IV_JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. Effective 1 June 1971, class HS Junior ROTC units will be established at the following institutions under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence September 1971:

Winter Haven Senior School, Winter Haven, Florida Middleton High School, Charleston, South Carolina Goose Creek High School, Goose Creek, South Carolina

2. Effective 1 July 1971, the class MI Junior ROTC unit at Cardinal Farley Military Academy, Rhinecliff-on-Hudson, New York will be disestablished.
3. Effective 1 July 1971, the class MI Junior ROTC unit at Xavier High School, New York, New York is reclassified as a class HS Junior ROTC unit under the provisions of AR 145-2.
