I..GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 16 July 1971, the Commanding Officer, United States Army Administrative School Center and Fort Benjamin Harrison, Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 August 1971*.

II..GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Section I, DA General Orders 20, 1965, designating the Commanding Officer, United States Army Edgewood Arsenal, Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland, as a general courts-martial convening authority, is rescinded.

III..EDGEWOOD ARSENAL, MARYLAND. *Effective 1 July 1971*, Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Army Materiel Command, is discontinued as an installation. Concurrently, Edgewood Arsenal is established as a class II activity at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Army Materiel Command.

IV..JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. *Effective 1 July 1971*, a class HS Junior ROTC unit was established at East Forsyth Senior High School, Kernersville, North Carolina, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence 1 September 1971.

2. *Effective 15 July 1971*, a class MI Junior ROTC unit was established at Charlotte Hall Military Academy, Charlotte Hall, Maryland, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence September 1971.

3. *Effective 1 July 1971*, class MI Junior ROTC units at the following institutions were disestablished:

Western Military Academy, Alton, Illinois
San Rafael Military Academy, San Rafael, California

4. *Effective 1 July 1971*, class HS Junior ROTC units at the following institutions were disestablished:

R. J. Reynolds High School, Winston-Salem, North Carolina
Central High School, St. Croix, Virgin Islands
Charlotte Amalie High School, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands

5. *Effective 15 July 1971*, class HS Junior ROTC units at the following institutions were disestablished:

Clinton High School, Clinton, Arkansas
Middleton High School, Charleston, South Carolina

6. *Effective 1 September 1971*, the class MI Junior ROTC unit at Sewanee Military Academy, Sewanee, Tennessee, will be disestablished.
