**I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL.** Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 28 July 1971, the Commanding Officer, Fort Sam Houston, Fort Sam Houston, Texas 78234, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial *effective 1 August 1971*.

**II. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL.** Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 28 July 1971, the Commanding Officer, Brooke Army Medical Center, Fort Sam Houston, Texas 78234, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6) to convene general courts-martial *effective 1 August 1971*.

**III. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL.** Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army of 19 August 1971, the Commanding Officer, 1st Infantry Division (Mech) (Forward), APO New York 09137, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial.

**IV. NATIONAL CEMETERY SUPERVISING OFFICE, COLUMBUS, OHIO.** 1. *Effective 1 October 1971*, the National Cemetery Supervising Office (NCSO), a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Support Services and located at the Defense Construction Supply Center, Columbus, Ohio, is discontinued.

2. All national cemeteries presently supervised by the NCSO, Columbus, Ohio, are to be reassigned to the NCSO's located at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Atlanta, Georgia; and Lathrop, California, respectively, in accordance with the approved plan of the Chief of Support Services. All personnel actions and fiscal adjustments, the transfer of property, and such other details as are necessary will be accomplished not later than 31 December 1971.
