I--GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal order of the Secretary of the Army, the Commanding Officer, United States Army Element, Headquarters, United States Readiness Command, MacDill Air Force Base, Florida, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 1 January 1972.

II--UNITED STATES ARMY NUCLEAR WEAPONS SURETY GROUP. Effective 1 November 1971, the United States Army Nuclear Weapons Surety Group is redesignated as the United States Army ~~Chemical and~~ Nuclear Surety Group.

III--WARRIOR OF THE PACIFIC TEAM COMPETITION. In accordance with paragraph 5-66, AR 145-1, the annual Warrior of the Pacific rifle competition was conducted at General Military Science ROTC training camps. Loyola University, New Orleans, Louisiana 70118, is announced as the winner of the Warrior of the Pacific trophy for the year 1971. Average score per man was 53.45.

IV--JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. Effective 1 August 1971, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit at South Girard High School, Phenix City, Alabama, was disestablished.

2. Effective 1 September 1971, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit at Aliceville High School, Aliceville, Alabama, was disestablished.

3. Effective 31 August 1971, the name of Southeast High School, Grand Rapids, Michigan, was changed to Ottawa Hills High School.

V--JUNIOR ROTC AND NDCC UNITS. 1. So much of section V, DA General Orders 46, 1971 pertaining to distinguished honor ROTC units is amended to add: "Cheyenne Central High School, Cheyenne, Wyoming".

2. So much of section V, DA General Orders 46, 1971 as pertains to Castle Heights Military Academy which reads: "Lebanon, Kentucky" is amended to read: "Lebanon, Tennessee".
