I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal orders of the Secretary of the Army, the Commanding Officer, United States Army Support Command, Cam Ranh Bay, APO San Francisco, 96312, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial *effective 1 November 1971*.

II. UNITED STATES ARMY ELEMENT, HEADQUARTERS, UNITED STATES STRIKE COMMAND, MacDILL AIR FORCE BASE, FLORIDA. *Effective 1 January 1972*, the United States Army Element, Headquarters, United States Strike Command, is discontinued.

III. UNITED STATES ARMY ELEMENT, UNITED STATES READINESS COMMAND, MacDILL AIR FORCE BASE, FLORIDA. *Effective 1 January 1972*, the United States Army Element, United States Readiness Command is organized with station at MacDill Air Force Base, Tampa, Florida.

IV. CORAOPOLIS ARMY TANK-AUTOMOTIVE STEEL FOUNDRY, PENNSYLVANIA. *Effective 21 May 1971*, the Coraopolis Army Tank-Automotive Steel Foundry, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Army Materiel Command, was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

V. MUSKEGON ARMY ENGINE PLANT, MICHIGAN. *Effective 1 May 1971*, the Muskegon Army Engine Plant, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Army Materiel Command, was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

VI. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. *Effective 1 November 1971*, a class IIS JUNIOR ROTC unit was established at Albert P. Brewer High School, Decatur, Alabama, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence school year 1972-73.

2. *Effective 1 November 1971*, class IIS JUNIOR ROTC units were established at the following institutions under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence January 1972.

Marianna High School, Marianna, Florida

Brownwood High School, Brownwood, Texas

3. *Effective 1 September 1971*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit at Linear High School, Shreveport, Louisiana was disestablished.
