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I. UNITED STATES ARMY BOARD FOR AVIATION ACCIDENT RESEARCH, FORT RUCKER, ALABAMA. *Effective 1 January 1972*, the United States Army Board for Aviation Accident Research is redesignated as the United States Army Agency for Aviation Safety (USAAVS) and remains a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development.

II. UNITED STATES ARMY NUCLEAR WEAPONS SURETY GROUP. Section II, DA General Orders 49, 1971, is amended to read as follows:
UNITED STATES ARMY NUCLEAR WEAPONS SURETY GROUP. *Effective 1 November 1971*, the United States Army Nuclear Weapons Surety Group is redesignated as the United States Army Nuclear and Chemical Surety Group.

III. JUNIOR ROTC UNIT. *Effective 1 November 1971*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit was established at Wirt High School, Gary, Indiana under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence school year 1972-73.

IV. NDCC UNIT. *Effective 1 November 1971*, the NDCC unit at Thomas Jefferson High School, Richmond, Virginia was disestablished.
