**I. UNITED STATES ARMY MILITARY MISSION WITH THE IMPERIAL IRANIAN GENDARMERIE (GENMISH).** *Effective 1 January 1972*, the US Army Military Mission with the Imperial Iranian Gendarmerie (GENMISH), Teheran, Iran, is transferred from the command jurisdiction of the Commander in Chief, US Strike Command/US Commander in Chief, Middle East/Southern Asia and Africa South of the Sahara (CINCSSTRIKE/USCINCEAFSA), to the command jurisdiction of the Commander in Chief, United States European Command (USCINCEUR).

**II. KINGSBURY ORDNANCE PLANT, INDIANA.** *Effective 16 November 1971*, Kingsbury Ordnance Plant, Indiana, a class II inactive installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

**III. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1.** *Effective 1 July 1972*, a class MI JUNIOR ROTC unit will be established at Greenbrier Military School, Lewisburg, West Virginia, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence 1 September 1972.

**2.** *Effective 1 March 1972*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit was established at Chavala High School, Seale, Alabama, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence school year 1972-73.

**3.** *Effective 1 April 1972*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit will be established at McLean County High School, Calhoun, Kentucky, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with Training to commence September 1972.

**4.** *Effective 1 July 1972*, class HS JUNIOR ROTC units will be established at Idaho Falls High School and Skyline High School, Idaho Falls, Idaho, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence 1 September 1972.

**5.** *Effective 1 September 1972*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit will be established at Bangor Christian School, Bangor, Maine, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence school year 1972-73.

**IV. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1.** *Effective 1 May 1972*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit will be established at Brownsville Consolidated Independent School District, Brownsville, Texas, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence in September 1974.

**2.** *Effective 9 June 1972*, the class MI JUNIOR ROTC unit at Bordentown Military Institute, Bordentown, New Jersey, will be disestablished.

**3.** *Effective 10 June 1972*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit will be established at Bordentown/Lenox School, Lenox, Massachusetts, under the provisions of AR 145-2 with training to commence school year 1972-73.

**V. JUNIOR ROTC UNIT.** *Effective 14 January 1972*, a class HS JUNIOR ROTC unit at Atkins High School, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, was disestablished.

**VI. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS.** 1. So much of section V, DA General Orders 46, 27 August 1971, pertaining to distinguished honor ROTC units is amended to add: "Southeast High School, Kansas City, Missouri".

2. So much of section V, DA General Orders 46, 27 August 1971, as pertains to Thomas Jefferson High School which reads: "Ashland, Kentucky" is amended to read: "Louisville, Kentucky".

**VII. NDCC UNIT.** *Effective 31 May 1972*, the NDCC unit at Albany Academy, Albany, New York, will be disestablished.
