I\_STEWART ANNEX. Effective I August 1972, that portion of the former Stewart Air Force Base, NY which has been officially transferred to the Department of the Army is designated Stewart Annex, a subinstallation of the West Point Military Reservation.

II\_US ARMY FINANCE SUPPORT AGENCY (USAFSA). Effective I July 1972, the Finance Center, US Army, established at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Ind., and designated by DA General Order 22, 4 May 1967, as a class II activity of the Comptroller of the Army, is redesignated the US Army Finance Support Agency, as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Comptroller of the Army.
