I.—GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal orders of the Secretary of the Army of 20 July 1972, the Commanding Officer, US Army Support Command, Hawaii (Prov), APO San Francisco 96557, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial *effective 15 August 1972*.

II.—UNITED STATES ARMY CLUB MANAGEMENT AGENCY (SHORT TITLE: USACMA). 1. *Effective 9 August 1972*, The United States Army Club Management Agency is established as a Class II Activity of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel.

2. The mission of the United States Army Club Management Agency is to exercise technical direction and supervision over the Army club system worldwide; to provide technical assistance and inspections for all Army clubs as required; to establish and command Regional Offices as required; to perform such other club management functions as may be assigned by Headquarters, Department of the Army; and make recommendations to higher, collateral, and lower echelons in regard to club management matters.

III.—HAYS ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT, PENNSYLVANIA. *Effective 8 February 1972*, Hays Army Ammunition Plant, Pennsylvania was established as a Class II installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command and *effective 30 June 1972* the plant was placed in an inactive status.

IV.—SIoux ARMY DEPOT, NEBRASKA. *Effective 29 March 1971*, Sioux Army Depot, Nebraska, a Class II inactive installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command, was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
