**I..US ARMY FORCES COMMAND.** *Effective 1 July 1973*, the United States Army Forces Command is established as a major Army Command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, with Headquarters at Fort McPherson, Georgia.

**II..US ARMY TRAINING AND DOCTRINE COMMAND.** *Effective 1 July 1973*, the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command is established as a major Army Command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, with Headquarters at Fort Monroe, Virginia.

**III..US ARMY COMBAT DEVELOPMENTS COMMAND.** *Effective 1 July 1973*, the United States Army Combat Developments Command, a subordinate major command of United States Continental Army Command, is discontinued.
