**I. VALLEY FORGE GENERAL HOSPITAL, PENNSYLVANIA.** Effective 1 July 1974, Valley Forge General Hospital, Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, an inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Health Services Command, is designated as a subinstallation of Fort Detrick, Maryland.

**II. CHARLESTON ARMY DEPOT, SOUTH CAROLINA.** Effective 30 June 1974, Charleston Army Depot, Charleston, South Carolina, an installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command, is placed in an inactive status.

**III. US ARMY COUNTERINTELLIGENCE ANALYSIS DETACHMENT (SFW3YSAA).** Effective 1 July 1974, the US Army Counterintelligence Analysis Detachment (SFW3YSAA), a Staff Support Agency under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence, HQDA, is designated a Field Operating Activity.
