I\_UNITED STATES ARMY SAFEGUARD COMMAND (SAFCMD) (ADW3F9AA). Effective 3 September 1974, the United States Army SAFE-GUARD Command, Nekoma, ND, US Army Surveillance Battalion (PAR) (ADW3GBAA) and the US Army Ballistic Missile Defense Center, (ADW3QXAA) are relieved from assignment to the Commanding General, United States Army Air Defense Command and are established as elements of the United States Army Ballistic Missile Defense Organization.

- II\_BALLISTIC MISSILE DEFENSE OPERATIONS ACTIVITY. a. Effective 3 September 1974, the Ballistic Missile Defense Operations Activity (BMDOA) (SCW34DAA) Colorado Springs, Colorado, is established as an element of the United States Army Ballistic Missile Defense Organization.
- b. Concurrently the Ballistic Missile Defense Operations Activity is assigned to the Commanding General, United States Army Air Defense Command less operational control.
- c. Effective 17 December 1974, the BMDOA is relieved of assignment to the United States Army Air Defense Command and reverts to its parent organization.
