- I\_US ARMY PACIFIC. Effective 31 December 1974, the US Army Pacific, a major Army command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, is discontinued.
- II\_EIGHTH US ARMY. Effective 1 January 1975, the Eighth US Army is discontinued as a major subordinate command under the jurisdiction of US Army Pacific and designated as a major Army command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, with Headquarters at Yong San, Korea. The Eighth US Army is assigned as a component command of US Forces Korea.
- III\_US ARMY JAPAN. Effective 1 January 1975, the US Army Japan is discontinued as a major subordinate command under the jurisdiction of US Army Pacific and designated as a major Army command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, with Headquarters at Camp Zama, Japan. The US Army Japan is assigned as a component command of US Forces Japan.
- IV\_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Confirming verbal orders of the Secretary of the Army of 31 October 1974, the Commanding Officer, 172d Infantry Brigade (Alaska), is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial effective 1 December 1974.
- V\_FORT MACARTHUR, CALIFORNIA. Effective 1 January 1975, Fort MacArthur, California, is designated a subinstallation of Fort Ord, California, an installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Training and Doctrine Command.
- VI\_US ARMY CINCPAC SUPPORT GROUP. Effective 1 January 1975, the US Army CINCPAC Support Group (Unit Identification Code Number W32FAA) is established as a Field Operating Agency under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, under the staff supervision of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans, with headquarters at Ft. Shafter, Hawaii.
