**I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL.** Confirming verbal orders of the Secretary of the Army of 31 March 1975, the Commander, United States Army Garrison, Okinawa, APO San Francisco 96331, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial effective 31 March 1975.

**II. FORT HANCOCK, NJ.** Effective 31 December 1974, Fort Hancock, NJ, a subinstallation of Fort Hamilton, NY, an installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Forces Command, was placed in an inactive status.

**III. JUNIOR ROTC UNIT.** Effective 1 July 1975, the status of the Junior ROTC unit at Antilles Military Academy, Trujillo Alto, Puerto Rico, was changed from class HS to class MI JROTC.
