WASHINGTON, DC, 12 September 1975**MILITARY REVIEW BOARDS AGENCY**

1. Continuance of Board. The Army Discharge Review Board previously established on 29 June 1944 as the Secretary of War's Discharge Review Board and created under the authority of Section 1553, Title 10, USC, is continued as an administrative agency of the Office of the Secretary of the Army under the administrative supervision of the Army Council of Review Boards and the operational control of the Military Review Boards Agency.

2. Establishment of Panels. Effective 31 October 1975, Regional Panels of the Army Discharge Review Board are established as tenant activities at the following locations:

1. Panels A and B: ADRB, Washington, DC.
2. Panel C: Presidio, San Francisco, CA.
3. Panel D: Fort Benjamin Harrison, IN.
4. Panel E: Fort McPherson, GA.
5. Panel F: Fort Carson, CO.

a. Members and staff of the Army Discharge Review Board will be assigned for strength accounting to the Military Review Boards Agency, Office, Secretary of the Army, or detailed by installation commanders concerned as requested by the President, Army Discharge Review Board.

b. The panels will function under the administrative control of the Director, Army Council of Review Boards, and under the Operational control of the President, Army Discharge Review Board, as outlined in Section 1553, Title 10, USC and AR 15-180.

c. Administrative support will be provided by the Office, Secretary of the Army or, when appropriate, by installation commanders when requested by the President, Army Discharge Review Board.

3. Recession. War Department Bulletin Number 10, 29 June 1944, is rescinded.
