**I. NATICK LABORATORIES.** Effective 4 March 1975, Natick Laboratories, Massachusetts, an installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command, was redesignated as Natick Development Center.

**II. CORNHUSKER ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT.** Effective 13 October 1973, Cornhusker Army Ammunition Plant, Nebraska, an installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command, was placed in an inactive status.

**III. FORT BARRY.** Effective 10 September 1974, Fort Barry, California, a subinstallation of the Presidio of San Francisco, under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Forces Command, was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

**IV. FORT CRONKHITE.** Effective 10 September 1974, Fort Cronkhite, California, a subinstallation of the Presidio of San Francisco, under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Forces Command, was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

**V. US ARMY ST. LOUIS AREA SUPPORT CENTER, ILLINOIS.** Section I, DA General Orders 35, 1972 is rescinded.

**VI. GRANITE CITY ARMY DEPOT, ILLINOIS.** Section II, DA General Orders 35, 1972 is amended to read: Effective 30 June 1972 Granite City Army Depot, Granite City, Illinois, a class II inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command is discontinued. Concurrently, the US Army St. Louis Area Support Center Granite City, Illinois is established as a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Command.
