I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commander, 21st Support Command (TAACOM), APO New York 09325, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial effective 19 August 1976.

II. MILITARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT COMMAND (MTMC). 1. *Effective 1 July 1976.* Military Traffic Management Command (MTMC) is assigned the mission and responsibility for operation of military water terminals in Northern and Central Europe. On the same date, US Army, Europe and Seventh Army is relieved of responsibilities and mission for operation of these terminals which are currently operational in the Federal Republic of Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, Great Britain, and Portugal. Personnel spaces, funds, programs, and budgets related to the assignment to MTMC of mission responsibility for operation of military ocean terminals in Northern and Central Europe will be transferred to MTMC effective 1 October 1976.

2. *Effective 1 October 1976,* Military Traffic Management Command is assigned the mission and responsibility for operation of the common user ocean terminal at Leghorn, Italy. On the same date, US Army, Europe and Seventh Army is relieved of mission responsibility for water terminal operations at Leghorn, Italy. Also, on the same date, the personnel spaces, funds, programs, and budgets related to the mission responsibility will be transferred to MTMC.

III. US ARMY SAFEGUARD COMMAND (SAFCMD). The United States Army SAFEGUARD Command, Nekoma, ND, UIC W3F9 is discontinued effective 31 August 1976.

IV. US ARMY COMPUTER SYSTEMS COMMAND SUPPORT GROUP (PACIFIC). *Effective 1 January 1973,* the US Army Computer Systems Command Support Group (Pacific) is attached for the exercise of general, special and summary court-martial jurisdiction and the general administration of military justice including Article 15, Uniform Code of Military Justice, to Commander US Army Support Command Hawaii. Authority is granted to delegate further this attachment.

V. US ARMY COMPUTER SYSTEMS COMMAND SUPPORT GROUP, PRESIDIO. *Effective 1 July 1973*, the US Army Computer Systems Command Support Group, Presidio is attached for the exercise of general, special and summary court-martial jurisdiction and the general administration of military justice including Article 15, Uniform Code of Military Justice, to Commander Presidio of San Francisco. Authority is granted to delegate further this attachment.

VI. US ARMY COMPUTER SYSTEMS COMMAND UNIT SYSTEMS FIELD ASSISTANCE TEAM, OKINAWA. *Effective 31 March 1975*, the US Army Computer Systems Command Unit Systems Field Assistance Team, Okinawa is attached for the exercise of general, special and summary court-martial jurisdiction and the general administration of military justice including Article 15, Uniform Code of Military Justice, to Commander US Army Garrison Okinawa. Authority is granted to delegate further this attachment.

VII. SENIOR ROTC UNIT. *Effective school year 1976-77*, the curriculum at LaSalle College, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was changed to include Field Artillery Branch Material and General Military Science (GMS) in the Senior ROTC program.

VIII. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. The Junior ROTC unit at Heidelberg American High School, Heidelberg, Germany, has been selected an honor unit with distinction for school year 1975-1976.
