I. FEDERAL PROCUREMENT INSTITUTE. 1. Effective 14 July 1976, the Federal Procurement Institute (UIC: JAW 39FAA) is established pursuant to the direction of the Administrator for Federal Procurement Policy (as authorized by Public Law 93-400, 30 August 1974). (The Department of Defense serves as Executive Agent for this Interagency Institute and the Office, Secretary of the Army has been designated its Administrative and Support Agent.)

2. The Federal Procurement Institute is to be the focal point for coordinating Government-wide planning, development, implementation, and evaluation of programs in procurement research, education, training, and career development.

II. DEFENSE SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT SCHOOL, FORT BELVOIR, VIRGINIA. Effective 19 July 1976, the Defense Systems Management School is redesignated the Defense Systems Management College.

III. US ARMY TANK-AUTOMOTIVE COMMAND. Effective 1 July 1976, the US Army Tank-Automotive Command is redesignated as the US Army Tank-Automotive Materiel Readiness Command (TARCOM).

IV. US ARMY MOBILITY SYSTEMS LABORATORY. Effective 1 July 1976, the US Army Mobility Systems Laboratory is redesignated as the US Army Tank-Automotive Research and Development Command.

V. US ARMY ARCTIC TEST CENTER. Effective 1 July 1976, the US Army Arctic Test Center is redesignated as the US Army Cold Regions Test Center.

VI. US ARMY PRODUCTION EQUIPMENT AGENCY. Effective 1 July 1976, the US Army Production Equipment Agency is redesignated as the US Army Industrial Base Engineering Activity.

VII. US ARMY MILPERCEN PERSONNEL ASSISTANCE POINT. Effective 1 September 1976 the US Army MILPERCEN Personnel Assistance Point, John F Kennedy International Airport is established as a field operating activity of the US Army Military Personnel Center.

VIII. US ARMY MAINTENANCE PLANT, MAINZ. Effective 1 July 1976, the US Army Maintenance Plant, Mainz (W109AA) is transferred from US Army Europe to US Army Materiel Development and Readiness Command.

IX. US ARMY MAINTENANCE PLANT, OBER-RAMSTADT. Effective 1 July 1976, the US Army Maintenance Plant, Ober-Ramstadt (W11AAA) is transferred from US Army Europe to US Army Materiel Development and Readiness Command.

X. NATIONAL DEFENSE CADET CORPS UNITS. 1. Effective 1 July 1976, a NDCC unit is established at James Madison High School, Dallas, Texas.

2. Effective 24 August 1976, a NDCC unit is established at Glenwood School for Boys, Glenwood, Illinois.

XI. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. The following Junior ROTC units will be established as outlined below:
