I..US ARMY MEDICAL RESEARCH UNIT. Effective 1 October 1976, the following organization/unit is attached, as indicated, for the exercise of general courts-martial jurisdiction and the general administration of military justice, excluding Article 15, UCMJ, jurisdiction, and including related administrative actions as requested by the attached organization/unit. II..US ARMY SECURITY ASSISTANCE AGENCY LATIN AMERICA. Effective 1 October 1976, the US Army Security Assistance Agency Latin America (Unit Identification Code Number: SFW39SAA) Fort Amador, Canal Zone, is established as a Field Operating Agency of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

III..US ARMY NUCLEAR AGENCY. Effective 1 October 1976 the US Army Nuclear Agency (WOHOAA) at Fort Bliss, TX is discontinued.

IV..US ARMY NUCLEAR AND CHEMICAL SURETY GROUP. Effective 1 October 1976 the US Army Nuclear and Chemical Surety Group (WOJ5AA) at Fort Belvoir, VA is redesignated as the US Army Nuclear Agency and remains a field operating agency of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans at Fort Belvoir, VA. The assets of the former US Army Nuclear Agency, Fort Bliss, TX, will be absorbed by the new US Army Nuclear Agency, Fort Belvoir, VA, and will remain at Fort Bliss, TX.

V..JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. The following Junior ROTC units were disestablished effective dates indicated:
