I_UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES BICENTENNIAL BAND (AGW311) (SHORT TITLE: USAFBB). Effective 31 March 1977, the United States Armed Forces Bicentennial Band (AGW311) is disestablished as a Field Operating Activity of The Adjutant General Center. All mission related functions will be terminated 31 March 1977. Concurrently, personnel and equipment will be distributed in accordance with existing requirements and regulations.

- II_NATIONAL DEFENSE CADET CORPS UNITS. 1. So much of DA General Orders Number 18, Section X, 30 September 1976, as reads "Effective 24 August 1976, a NDCC unit was established at Glenwood School for Boys, Glenwood, Illinois," is disestablished effective immediately because Glenwood School for Boys is not a new NDCC unit.
- 2. In addition, so much of DA General Orders Number 3, Section II, 27 February 1976, as reads "Effective 1 January 1976, a NDCC unit was established at Lely High School, Naples, Florida," is disestablished effective 31 August 1976.
