I.. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commander, United States Army Military Police School/Training Center and Fort McClellan, Fort McClellan, Alabama, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial effective 8 November 1976.

II.. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Section I, DA General Orders 11, 1976, designating the Commander, United States Army Missile Materiel Readiness Command, to convene general courts-martial, effective 15 June 1976, is rescinded.

III.. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commander, United States Army Missile Materiel Readiness Command, is designated by the Secretary of the Army pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial effective 31 January 1977.

IV.. ARMY OPERATIONS CENTER. Effective 8 November 1976, personnel and equipment associated with the Army Operations Center (a full-time command and control facility for Headquarters, Department of the Army) are transferred from US Army Command and Control Support Agency (SFW241AA) to Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans (CSWOZ2AA), Headquarters, Department of the Army.

V.. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. The following Junior ROTC units will be established as outlined below:
