I. BADGER ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT, WISCONSIN. Effective 15 November 1977, Badger Army Ammunition Plant, an active Army installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Materiel Development and Readiness Command, was placed in an inactive status.

II. FORT HANCOCK, NEW JERSEY. Effective 18 November 1977, Fort Hancock, an inactive installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, US Army Training and Doctrine Command, was discontinued as an Army installation.

III. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. Effective 1 December 1977, Junior ROTC units were established at the following high schools with training to commence not later than school year 1978-1979.
