- I—DIRECTORATE OF MILITARY PROGRAMS, CHIEF OF ENGINEERS, US ARMY. 1. Effective 29 September 1978, the Directorate of Military Programs is established as a staff element under the supervision of the Chief of Engineers.
- 2. The mission of the Directorate of Military Programs is to assist the Chief of Engineers in executing his Army staff and command mission responsibilities for real property maintenance activities, installation planning, stationing, military construction, engineering, and Army housing management.
- II—DIRECTORATE OF MILITARY CONSTRUCTION, CHIEF OF ENGINEERS, US ARMY. Effective 29 September 1978, the Directorate of Military Construction is discontinued. Concurrently, personnel and equipment are transferred to the Directorate of Military Programs.
- IV—GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commander, United States Army Support Activity, Okinawa, APO San Francisco 96331, is designated by the Secretary of the Army pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial effective 30 September 1978.
- KODER L. High School, Baton Rouge, Louisiana was disestablished.
