II_ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE ARMY (IL&FM). Effective 24 December 1978, the Assistant Secretary of the Army (IL&FM) is designated the Army Safety and Occupational Health Official.

III. ARMY STAFF SAFETY FUNCTION. Effective 24 December 1978, the Army Staff safety function is transferred from The Inspector General to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel.

IV. UNITED STATES ARMY AGENCY FOR AVIATION SAFETY. Effective 24 December 1978, the United States Army Agency for Aviation Safety, a field operating agency under the jurisdiction of The Inspector General, is transferred, as a field operating agency under the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, and redesignated the United States Army Safety Center.

V. JUNIOR ROTC UNIT. Effective 30 June 1979, the Junior ROTC unit at Wilbur D. Mills High School, Little Rock, Arkansas will be disestablished.
