WASHINGTON, DC, 28 March 1979US ARMY CINCPAC SUPPORT GROUP (CSG), HAWAII
(UIC: W32FAA)

1. Effective 23 March 1979, the US Army CINCPAC Support Group (CSG), Hawaii is redesignated as the US Army Western Command, a major Army Command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, with headquarters at Ft. Shafter, Hawaii.

2. **Mission.** The mission of Headquarters, US Army Western Command is to serve as the Army component to CINCPAC for the Pacific Command, less the geographical areas of Japan and Korea, and for matters of CINCPAC concern beyond the exclusive authority or transcending the geographical area of Commander, Eighth US Army and Commander, US Army Japan. The US Army Western Command will command and support assigned and attached Active US Army and USAR units, installations, and activities in Hawaii and in possessions and trust territories administered by the United States in PACOM and perform theaterwide functions for the Army in PACOM as directed by DA.
