I. . . MILITARY POSTAL SERVICE The Secretary of the Army has been designated as the Single Manager of the Military Postal Service and shall establish and organize the military Postal Service Agency. The Secretary of the Army further designates The Adjutant General as Executive Director, Military Postal Service Agency.

II. . . MILITARY POSTAL SERVICE AGENCY Effective 1 June 1980, Postal Directorate, The Adjutant General's Office is redesignated as the Military Postal Service Agency (AGW4FXAA), Washington, DC 20314 and established as a Field Operating Agency of The Adjutant General's Office, Headquarters, Department of the Army.
