**ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 16TH
 INFANTRY REGIMENT UNDER THE US ARMY
 REGIMENTAL SYSTEM**

1. The 16th Infantry regiment is WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the US Army Regimental System, effective 28 February 1983. The 1st Bn, UIC: WAHRAA remains ASSIGNED to the 1st Infantry Division (Fwd in Germany and the 2d Bn, UIC: WAHSAA remains ASSIGNED to the 1st Infantry Division at Fort Riley, KS.

2. INACTIVATE the 1st Bn, 28th Infantry, UIC: WAHXAA under MTOE 7-45HFC58, FC2082 at Fort Riley, KS, effective 28 February 1983. The 5th Bn, 16th Infantry, UIC: WH9TAA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 1st Infantry Division at Fort Riley, KS under MTOE 7-45HFC58, FC2082 with the following strengths: STSTR: 39 OFF, 2 WO, 800 ENL, 841 AGG-AUSTR: 38 OFF, 2 WO, 732 ENL, 772 AGG, effective 28 February 1983.

3. INACTIVATE the 1st Bn, 26th Infantry, UIC: WAHVAA under MTOE 7-45HE101, E10183 in Germany, effective 24 February 1983. The 4th Bn, 16th Infantry, UIC: WG54AA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 1st Infantry Division (Fwd) in Germany under MTOE 7-45HE101, E10183 with the following strengths: STSTR 40 OFF, 2 WO, 812 ENL, 854 AGG-AUSTR: 33 OFF, 2 WO, 738 ENL, 773 AGG, effective 24 February 1983.
