**ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE
 5TH FIELD ARTILLERY REGIMENT
 UNDER THE US ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM**

Department of the Army General Orders 8, 10 February 1983 is AMENDED to change the effective date in the following paragraphs as indicated:

2. The 2d Bn, 5th Field Artillery, UIC: WA14AA will be REORGANIZED at zero strength, RELIEVED from ASSIGNMENT to the V Corps in Germany and REASSIGNED to the 1st Infantry Division at Fort Riley, KS under MTOE 6-445HE102, E10283, effective 15 April 1983.

3. INACTIVATE the 1st Bn, 7th Field Artillery, UIC: WAHQAA under MTOE 6-365HFC79, FC1182 at Fort Riley, KS, effective 16 April 1983. The 2d Bn, 5th Field Artillery, UIC: WA14AA will be REORGANIZED under the 1st Infantry Division at Fort Riley, KS under MTOE 6-365HFC79, FC 1182 with the following strengths; STSTR: 42 OFF, 2 WO, 563 ENL, 607 AGG-AUSTR: 41 OFF, 2 WO, 537 ENL, 580 AGG, effective 16 April 1983.

6. The 4th Bn, 77th Field Artillery, UIC: WFJ8AA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the V Corps in Germany under MTOE 6-445HE102, E10283 with the following strengths: STSTR; 28 OFF, 2 WO, 462 ENL, 492 AGG-AUSTR: 26 OFF; 2 WO, 420 ENL, 448 AGG, effective 15 April 1983.
