## ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 3D FIELD ARTILLERY REGIMENT UNDER THE US ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM

- 1. The 3d Field Artillery regiment is WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the US Army Regimental System, effective 1 October 1983. - 3. INACTIVATE the 1st Bn, 14th Field Artillery, UIC: WADXAA under MTOE 6-365HE102, E10584 in Germany, effective 1 October 1983. The 4th Bn, 3d Field Artillery, UIC: WH9WAA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 2d Armored Division (Fwd) in Germany under MTOE 6-365HE102, E10584 with the following strengths: STSTR: 36 OFF, 2 WO, 534 ENL, 572 AGG-AUSTR: 36 OFF, 2 WO, 534 ENL, 572 AGG, effective 1 October 1983.
- 4. INACTIVATE the 6th Bn, 9th Field Artillery, UIC: WA15AA under MTOE 6-445HE104, E10182 in Germany, effective 1 October 1983. The 5th Bn, 3d Field Artillery, UIC: WH9XAA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to USAREUR in Germany under MTOE 6-445HE104, E10282 with the following strengths: STSTR: 28 OFF, 3 WO, 496 ENL, 527 AGG-AUSTR: 26 OFF, 2 WO, 419 ENL, 447 AGG, effective 1 October 1983.
