**ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE
8TH INFANTRY REGIMENT UNDER THE US ARMY REGIMENTAL
SYSTEM**

1. The 8th Infantry regiment is **WITHDRAWN** from the Combat Arms Regimental System and **REORGANIZED** under the US Army Regimental System, effective 1 August 1984. The 1st Bn, UIC: WAKBAA remains **ASSIGNED** to the 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, CO.

2. **INACTIVATE** the 1st Bn, 22d Infantry, UIC: WAKKAA under MTOE 7-245JFC04, FC 1084 at Fort Carson, CO, effective 1 August 1984. The 2d Bn, 8th Infantry, UIC: WAKCAA will be **ACTIVATED** and **ASSIGNED** to the 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, CO under MTOE 7-245JFC04, FC1084 with the following strengths: STSTR: 45 OFF, 2 WO, 822 ENL, 869 AGG-AUSTR: 45 OFF, 2 WO, 822 ENL, 869 AGG, effective 1 August 1984.

3. **INACTIVATE** the 2d Bn, 28th Infantry, UIC: WAHWAA under MTOE 7-245JE103, E10384 in Germany, effective 1 August 1984. The 3d Bn, 8th Infantry, UIC: WAKDAA will be **ACTIVATED** and **ASSIGNED** to the 8th Infantry Division in Germany under MTOE 7-245JE103, E10384 with the following strengths: STSTR: 45 OFF, 2 WO, 821 ENL, 868 AGG-AUSTR: 45 OFF, 2 WO, 781 ENL, 828 AGG, effective 1 August 1984.

4. **INACTIVATE** the 2d Bn, 13th Infantry, UIC: WAPTAA under MTOE 7-245JE106, E10384 in Germany, effective 1 August 1984. The 4th Bn, 8th Infantry, UIC: WH80AA will be **ACTIVATED** and **ASSIGNED** to the 8th Infantry Division in Germany under MTOE 7-245JE106, E10384 with the following strengths: STSTR: 45 OFF, 2 WO, 821 ENL, 868 AGG-AUSTR: 44 OFF, 2 WO, 782 ENL, 829 AGG, effective 1 August 1984.
