FORT DRUM, NEW YORK—Redesignation I
U.S. ARMY SCHOOL OF THE AMERICAS (W4UBAA)—Transfer II

I—FORT DRUM, NEW YORK. Effective 1 October 1985, Fort Drum, New York, a semi-active installation, is designated an active Army installation under the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Forces Command.

II—U.S. ARMY SCHOOL OF THE AMERICAS (W4UBAA). Effective 16 April 1985, the U.S. Army School of the Americas (USARSA) is transferred from the U.S. Army Security Assistance Agency (Latin America) (W39SAA), and becomes a TRADOC school under the command of the Combined Arms Center, Fort Leavenworth, KS.
