75th RANGER REGIMENT

I—Effective 3 February 1986, the lineage and honors of the World War II ranger battalions and the Korean War ranger companies that are perpetuated by the 1st Special Forces are transferred to the 75th Infantry.

 $\mathbf{II}\text{--}\mathbf{Effective}$ 3 February 1986, the 75th Infantry is redesignated as the 75th Ranger Regiment.

III—Effective 3 February 1986, the 75th Ranger Regiment is withdrawn from the Combat Arms Regimental System and reorganized under the United States Army Regimental System.
