ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS, THE SIGNAL CORPS AND THE CHEMICAL CORPS AS REGIMENTS IN THE US ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

- The Corps of Engineers is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 26 December 1985. The home of the Corps of Engineers is ESTABLISHED at Fort Belvoir, Virginia.
- The Signal Corps is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 1 June 1986. The home of the Signal Corps is ESTABLISHED at Ford Gordon, Georgia.
- 3. The Chemical Corps is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 28 June 1986. The home of the Chemical Corps is ESTABLISHED at Fort McClellan, Alabama.
