ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ARMY MEDICAL DEPARTMENT, THE CHAPLAINS BRANCH AND MILITARY INTELLIGENCE AS REGIMENTS IN THE US ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

- 1. For purposes of the US Army Regimental System, the Army Medical Department is established as the Army Medical Department Corps. The Army Medical Department Corps is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 27 July 1986. The home of the Army Medical Department Corps is ESTABLISHED at Fort Sam Houston, Texas.
- 2. For purposes of the US Army Regimental System, the Chaplains Branch is established as the Chaplain Corps. The Chaplain Corps is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 29 July 1986. The home of the Chaplain Corps is ESTABLISHED at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey.
- 3. For purposes of the US Army Regimental System, Military Intelligence is established as the Military Intelligence Corps. The Military Intelligence Corps is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 1 July 1987. The home of the Military Intelligence Corps is ESTABLISHED at Fort Huachuca, Arizona.
