UNITED STATES ARMY, SOUTH (USARSO) (193D INFANTRY BRIGADE (PANAMA)) (UIC: FCWARU98)

- 1. Effective 4 December 1986, the United States Army, South (USARSO) is activated as a major Army command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army, with headquarters at Ft. Clayton, Republic of Panama. The USARSO will be formed from assets of the 193D Infantry Brigade (Panama).
- 2. Mission. The mission of the United States Army, South is to serve as the Army component to CINCSOUTH for the U.S. SOUTHERN Command. The United States Army, South will command and support assigned and attached Active and Reserve Component U.S. Army units, installations and activities in Latin America.
