ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 8TH CAVALRY REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

- 1. The 8th Cavalry regiment will be WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the U.S. Army Regimental System, effective 16 February 1987. The 1st Bn, UIC: WAGSAA and the 2d Bn, UIC: WAGRAA remain ASSIGNED to the 1st Cavalry Division at Fort Hood, TX.
- 2. The 1st Bn, 33d Armor, UIC: WAEZAA will be INACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 17-235DJE104, E10186, effective 16 February 1987. The 3d Bn, 8th Cavalry, UIC: WAEZAA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 3d Armored Division in Germany under MTOE 17-235JE104, E10186 with the following strengths: STSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGG-AUSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGG, effective 16 February 1987.
- 3. The 3d Bn, 33d Armor, UIC: WAE1AA will be INACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 17-235JE104, E10186, effective 16 February 1987. The 4th Bn, 8th Cavalry, UIC: WAE1AA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 3d Armored Division in Germany under MTOE 17-235JE104, E10186 with the following strengths: STSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGG-AUSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGG, effective 16 February 1987.
