I—ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ADJUTANT GENERAL'S CORPS UNDER THE US ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS). The Adjutant General's Corps is placed under the US Army Regimental System effective 17 June 1987. The home of the Adjutant General's Corps is ESTABLISHED at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana.

II—ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 11TH FIELD ARTILLERY REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS). Section I, Department of the Army General Orders No. 36 is AMENDED to delete paragraph 4 in its entirety and the following substituted thereafter:

"4. The 5th Bn, 11th Field Artillery, UIC: WC17AA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 6th Infantry Division at Fort Wainwright, AK under MTOE 6-125JFC06, FC1587 with the following strengths: STSTR: 22 OFF, 4 WO, 195 ENL, 221 AGG-AUSTR: 22 OFF, 4 WO, 195 ENL, 221 AGG, effective 17 October 1986."
