- 3. The 5th Bn, 33d Armor, UIC: WAZAAA will be INACTIVATED at Fort Knox, KY under MTOE 17-235JFC04, FC2185, effective 16 June 1987. The 2d Bn, 10th Cavalry, UIC: WAZAAA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 194th Armored Bde at Fort Knox, KY under MTOE 17-235JFC04, FC2185 with the following strengths: STSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGGAUSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 50 EN
