**ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE
508TH INFANTRY REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY
REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)**

1. The 508th Infantry regiment will be WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the U.S. Army Regimental System, effective 10 July 1987.

2. The 2d Bn, 187th Infantry, UIC: WG6UAA will be INACTIVATED at Fort Kobbe, Panama under MTOE 7-15JSU94, SU1187, effective 10 July 1987. The 1st Bn, 508th Infantry, UIC: WG6UAA will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 193d Infantry Brigade at Fort Kobbe, Panama under MTOE 7-15JSU94, SU1187 with the following strengths: STSTR: 34 OFF, 1 WO, 545 ENL, 580 AGG-AUSTR: 34 OFF, 1 WO, 545 ENL, 580 AGG, effective 10 July 1987.
