HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON, DC, 17 August 1987

REORGANIZATION OF HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY

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I—OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL (W0Z6AA). Effective 30 March 1987, the Office of the Inspector General, an Army Staff agency, is transferred to the Office of the Secretary of the Army. The Inspector General reports to the Secretary of the Army and is responsive to the Chief of Staff, Army.

II—OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL (WONTAA). Effective 30 March 1987, The Auditor General, an Army Staff position, is transferred to the Office, Secretary of the Army. The Auditor General reports to the Secretary of the Army and is responsive to the Chief of Staff, Army.

III—OFFICE OF THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF FOR INFORMATION MANAGEMENT (W4NJAA). Effective 30 March 1987, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Information Management, an Army Staff agency, is redesignated as the Office of the Director of Information Systems for Command, Control, Communications, and Computers and is transferred to the Office of the Secretary of Army. The Director of Information Systems for Command, Control, Communications, and Computers assumes responsibility for the information management function less acquisition from the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management).

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IV—UNITED STATES ARMY INFORMATION MANAGE-MENT SUPPORT AGENCY (W4XFAA). Effective 30 March 1987, the United States Army Information Management Support Agency is established as a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army, under the supervision and control of the Director of Information Systems for Command, Control, Communications and Computers.

V—UNITED STATES ARMY PUBLICATIONS AND PRINT-ING AGENCY (W4XGAA). Effective 30 March, 1987, the United States Army Publications and Printing Agency is established as a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army, under the supervision and control of the Director of Information Systems for Command, Control, Communications and Computers.

VI—UNITED STATES ARMY PUBLICATIONS DISTRIBUTION CENTERS (W4XGAA). Effective 30 March 1987, the United States Army Publications Distribution Center, St. Louis, Missouri and the United States Army Publications Distribution Center, Baltimore, Maryland are designated as field operating activities of the United States Army Publications and Printing Agency.

VII—COMMAND SYSTEMS INTEGRATION AGENCY (W4MXAA). Effective 30 March 1987, the Command Systems Integration Office is redesignated as the Command Systems Integration Agency, a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army, under the control and supervision of the Director of Information Systems for Command, Control, Communications, and Computers.

VIII—INSTALLATION MANAGEMENT DIVISION, OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER OF THE ARMY. Effective 30 March 1987, the Installation Management Division of the Office of the Comptroller of the Army is transferred to the Office, Chief of Staff, Army, under the supervision and control of the Director of Management.

IX—UNITED STATES ARMY FINANCE AND ACCOUNTING CENTER (WONRAA). Effective 6 February 1987, the United States Army Finance and Accounting Center, a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army is transferred from the Office of the Comptroller of the Army to the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management).

X—UNITED STATES ARMY COST AND ECONOMIC ANALYSIS CENTER (W4PTAA). Effective 30 March 1987, the United States Army Cost and Economic Analysis Center, a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army is transferred from the Office of the Comptroller of the Army to the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management).

XI—OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER OF THE ARMY (W0ZWAA). Effective 30 March 1987, The Office of the Comptroller of the Army, an Army Staff agency, is transferred to the Office of the Secretary of the Army. The Comptroller of the Army reports to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management).

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XII—OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF FOR RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, AND ACQUISITION (W31WAA).

Effective 30 March 1987, the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Research, Development and Acquisition, an Army Staff agency, is transferred to the Office of the Secretary of the Army. The Deputy Chief of Staff for Research, Development and Acquisition is redesignated the Military Deputy to the Assistant Secretary of the Army and reports to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Research, Development and Acquisition). Rationalization, Standardization and Interoperability functions are concurrently transferred to the Office, Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans. Staff functions for conventional ammunition, tactical and support vehicles, other support equipment and industrial base preparedness are concurrently transferred to Headquarters, United States Army Materiel Command.

XIII—DIRECTORATE FOR CONTRACTING AND COMPETITION ADVOCATE GENERAL (W0Z3AA). Effective 30 March 1987, the Directorate for Contracting and Competition Advocate General, an Army Staff agency, is transferred from the Office, Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics to the Office of the Secretary of the Army, under the supervision and control of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Research, Development and Acquisition).

XIV—THE STUDY PROGRAM MANAGEMENT OFFICE (W0ZUAA). Effective 30 March 1987, the Study Program Management Office, is transferred from the Office of the Chief of Staff, Army to the Office, Secretary of the Army and designated as a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army under the supervision and control of the Deputy Under Secretary of the Army (Operations Research).

XV—WHITE HOUSE LIAISON OFFICE (W0ZUAA). Effective 30 April 1987, the White House Liaison Office is transferred from the Office of the Chief of Staff, Army to the Office of the Secretary of the Army under the supervision and control of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army.

XVI—THE SAFETY OFFICE (W4UPAA). Effective 29 June 1987 the Safety Office, an element of the United States Army Adjutant General Center, is transferred to Headquarters Services Washington, a joint Department of Defense activity, under the supervision and control of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army.

XVII—OFFICE, DIRECTOR OF ARMY SAFETY (W0ZUAA). Effective 30 June 1987, the Office, Director of Army Safety is established as an Army Staff element of the Office, Chief of Staff, Army, under the supervision and control of the Director of the Army Staff.

XVIII—UNITED STATES ARMY SAFETY CENTER (W4UNAA). Effective 30 June 1987, the United States Army Safety Center, Fort Rucker, Alabama, a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred from the Office of Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel to the Office, Chief of Staff, Army, under the supervision and control of the Director of the Army Staff.

XIX—UNITED STATES ARMY EQUIPMENT AUTHORIZATION REVIEW AGENCY (W0JDAA). Effective 30 April 1987, the United States Army Equipment Authorization Review Activity, a Headquarters

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Army Materiel Command Activity, is redesignated as a Field Operating Agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army under the supervision and control of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics.

XX—THE ARMY RESERVE FORCES POLICY COMMITTEE. Effective 30 March 1987, The Army Reserve Forces Policy Committee is transferred from the Office of the Chief of Staff, Army to the Office of the Secretary of the Army. The Chairman of the Army Reserve Forces Policy Committee reports to the Secretary of the Army and is responsive to the Chief of Staff,
