## ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 64TH ARMOR REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

- 1. The 64th Armor regiment will be WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the U.S. Army Regimental System, effective 16 November 1987. The 2d Bn, UIC: WAM8AA and the 3d Bn, UIC: WAM9AA remain assigned to the 3d Infantry Division in Germany and the 4th Bn, UIC: WFL9AA remains ASSIGNED to the 24th Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, GA.
- 2. The 5th Bn, 32d Armor, UIC: WAZDAA will be INACTIVATED at Fort Stewart, GA under MTOE 17–235JFC24, FC1186 effective 16 November 1987. The 1st Bn, 64th Armor, UIC: WAZDAA, will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 24th Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, GA under MTOE 17–235JFC24, FC1186 with the following strengths: STSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGG—AUSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 510 ENL, 552 AGG, effective 16 November 1987.
