## ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 7TH FIELD ARTILLERY REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

- 1. The 7th Field Artillery regiment will be WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the U.S. Army Regimental System, effective 16 April 1988. The 1st Bn, UIC: WAHQAA and the 2d Bn, UIC: WEQ2AA remain ASSIGNED to the 10th Mountain Division at Fort Drum, NY and the 3d Bn, UIC: WJAAAA and Btry F, UIC: WE24AA remain ASSIGNED to the 25th Infantry Division at Schofield Barracks, HI.
- 2. The 2d Bn, 92d Field Artillery, UIC: WA13AA will be INACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 6–445JE101, E10188, effective 16 April 1988. The 4th Bn, 7th Field Artillery, UIC: WA13AA will be ACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 6–445JE101, E10188 with the following strengths: STSTR: 35 OFF, 2 WO, 606 ENL, 643 AGG-AUSTR: 32 OFF, 2 WO, 564 ENL, 598 AGG, effective 16 April 1988.
