ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 14TH FIELD ARTILLERY REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

The 2d Bn, 14th Field Artillery, UIC: WA1YAA will be ACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 6-445JE101, E10188 with the following strengths: STSTR: 35 OFF, 2 WO, 606 ENL, 643 AGG-AUSTR: 32 OFF, 2 WO, 564 ENL, 598 AGG, effective 16 May 1988.
- 3. The 6th Bn, 10th Field Artillery, UIC: WA16AA will be INACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 6-445JE102, E10188, effective 16 May 1988. The 4th Bn, 14th Field Artillery, UIC: WA16AA will be ACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 6-445JE102, E10188 with the following strengths: STSTR: 35 OFF, 2 WO, 606 ENL, 643 AGG-AUSTR: 35 OFF, 2 WO, 522 ENL, 556 AGG, effective 16 May 1988.
