ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 123D AVIATION REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

Organic elements of the 1st Bn, 123d Aviation will be CONSTITUTED and ACTIVATED at Fort Ord, CA, effective 16 September 1987."
