**I—UNITED STATES ARMY COURIER SERVICE HEADQUARTERS.**

Effective 1 October 1987, the United States Army Courier Service Headquarters (AGWONCAA) is disestablished as a Class II Activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General of the U.S. Army and transferred to the United States Army Element of the Defense Courier Service Headquarters (JAW4VZAA) and is established in accordance with DOD Directive 5200.33. The Defense Courier Service is a joint service and DOD activity under the command and control of the Commander-in-Chief, Military Airlift Command, United States Air Force.

**II—UNITED STATES ARMY COURIER STATIONS.**

Effective 1 October 1987, the following United States Army Courier Stations, together with their functions, personnel, records, and equipment are disestablished as Class II Activities of The Adjutant General of the U.S. Army and transferred to the Defense Courier Service a joint service and DOD activity under the command and control of the Commander-in-Chief, Military Airlift Command, United States Air Force.


