ARMOR REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY
REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)**


1. The 70th Armor regiment will be WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the U.S. Army Regimental System, effective 16 June 1989. The 1st Bn, UIC: WASHAA and the 3d Bn, UIC: WAQ2AA remains ASSIGNED to the 5th Infantry Division at Fort Polk, LA and the 2d Bn, UIC: WHPMAA remains ASSIGNED to the 1st Armored Division in Germany.
2. The 2d Bn, 81st Armor will be INACTIVATED in Germany under MTOE 17-235JE102, E10388, effective 16 June 1989. The 4th Bn, 70th Armor will be ACTIVATED and ASSIGNED to the 1st Armored Division in Germany under MTOE 17-235JE102, E10388 with the following strengths: STSTR: 40 OFF, 2 WO, 517 ENL, 559 AGG-AUSTR: 34 OFF, 2 WO, 517 ENL, 553 AGG, effective 16 June 1989.
