**ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY ACQUISITION
EXECUTIVE SUPPORT AGENCY (AAESA)**

1. Effective 1 May 1990, the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (AAESA) (W27PAA) was ESTABLISHED as a staff support agency under the Office of the Army Acquisition Executive, Headquarters, Department of the Army. The AAESA will perform the following support functions.

Program Executive Office manpower/personnel resource support.
Acquisition Corps management support.
Acquisition information management support.

Headquarters, Department of the Army, offices and Army Commands currently performing these functions will support and be responsive to the AAESA.

2. Effective 1 May 1990, the Program Executive Office for Command and Control Systems and subordinate project/product management offices are TRANSFERRED from U.S. Army Communications-Electronics Command/Headquarters, U.S. Army Materiel Command (UIC: W44GAA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (UIC: W27P03).

3. Effective 1 May 1990, the Program Executive Office for Strategic Information Systems and subordinate project/product management offices are TRANSFERRED from Headquarters, Army Information Systems Command (UIC: W44NAA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (UIC: W27P06).

4. Effective 1 May 1990, the Program Executive Office for Communication Systems and its subordinate project/product management offices are TRANSFERRED from U.S. Army Communications-Electronics Command/Headquarters, U.S. Army Materiel Command (UIC: W44FAA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (UIC: W27P08).

5. Effective 1 May 1990, the Program Executive Office for Standard Army Management Information Systems and its subordinate project/product management offices are TRANSFERRED from Headquarters, U.S. Army Information Systems Command (UIC: W4Y0AA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (UIC: W27P11).

6. Effective 1 May 1990, the Program Manager Office for Joint Tactical Fusion and its subordinate project/product management offices are TRANSFERRED from Headquarters, U.S. Army Materiel Command (UIC: W4JKAA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (UIC: W27P14).

7. Effective 1 May 1990, the Army Information Management Office is TRANSFERRED from the U.S. Army Research Associates Group (UIC: W384AA) and ASSIGNED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (UIC: W27P00).

Effective 1 May 1990, the personnel and functions of the following Program Executive Offices/Program Management Offices and subordinate project/product management offices under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Army Materiel Command are TRANSFERRED to the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency as follows:


- Program Executive Office, Air Defense (UIC: W27P09)
