UNITED STATES ARMY OPERATIONAL TEST AND EVALUATION COMMAND

- 1. Effective 15 November 1990, the U.S. Army Operational Test and Evaluation Agency (OTEA) (SFW3Q2AA), a Field Operating Agency (FOA) of Headquarters, Department of the Army, Office, Chief of Staff, Army, was REDESIGNATED as the U.S. Army Operational Test and Evaluation Command (OPTEC) (SFW3Q2AA).
- 2. Effective 15 November 1990, the U.S. Army Test and Experimentation Command (TEXCOM) (TCW27RAA) was DISESTABLISHED as a subordinate command of the U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC). The mission, functions, personnel and all remaining assets of TEXCOM are transferred to OPTEC.
